Since August 2025, I have been here with **ONLY** two residents. I was burning out...training another brand new Christian graduate. Letting sinful residents stay too long. Enduring evil became too much. Katie said 3 days was too much, she promised 2 days a week because she is a pastors wife. Dauna went home. I called my Board members to tell them: Ann and Katrina are very challenging. I need one on one time with them. I don't want to take new ladies for awhile. I have been a drug addicted work-a-holic, worked with juvenile females, worked in a prison, and for 15 years, volunteered in jail and prison ministry. I know what they need: Jesus and hard truth.

On November 10th, Brenda Harvey (Computer Advisors) brought our computer, introduced me to her grand daughter, who was looking for a job. Then, Michelle Postawa and I talked, **AGAIN**. She wanted to come back; I wanted her back, doing social media, marketing, etc. (No disciplinary conversations). **THEN**, I thought, I should interview Allison again. I told her **ALL** of the most violent and insane things that have happened at WWT. Her words: "You don't talk too fast, I am sure you will teach me protocol, and I am not afraid to be tough. I think the three of us would mesh very well together." She used drugs briefly, has suffered great loss twice, and still has the joy of **JESUS**! She has a Bachelors Degree in Business, worked for three non-profits, and has excellent references. So here we are, exactly as I prayed.

What else is different: I am done fixing my house after 4 and a half years. No more stress.

Ann is working and has a vehicle. She is reunited with her daughter and preparing to be a mom. Katrina starts working in two weeks and is studying for her GED; both will pay a program fee of 25% of their income. They have more classes prior to graduating in Spring of 2026. We are ready for more residents.

None of this is easy as a donor-funded ministry that can not afford full time trained staff, refuses government money and doesn't compromise the residents safety. BUT GOD....

WWT raised \$122,000 from Jan to Aug 2025. For 2024, we raised \$141,738. But we didn't reopen until Sept 2024. So less expenses, and partial support staff expenses.

Something else happened in August of 2025. I had asked a donor for \$10,000 and received it two days later. THEN, someone across the USA, called and said I want to donate \$31,000 to WWT. I took this as a sign to pray for business help. God sent money, and he sent two helpers. Michelle and I worked well together, and both of us are much less stressed and more aware of the need to talk OFTEN. Allison will be an immense help. I want to pay both ladies what they are worth. I need your help.

FOR GIVING TUESDAY, we need your help to raise \$50,000. Thank you JESUS that up to \$15,000 will be matched. For the WWT 2026 budget items, we need to raise \$221,000:

\$19,300 for Resident Needs & Scholarships (We don't charge residents fees the first 6 months)

\$11,300 for Insurance (Building, Auto, Board)

\$143,700 for Staff (Was \$102,000, adjusted for one additional staff, IRA, Payroll Taxes, etc.)

\$13,250 for Fundraising (Event and Marketing expenses)

\$33,450 for Operating Expenses (Auto, Utilities, Office & Supplies, Security, IT, Materials, etc.)
