Taunting or Trusting

From Sonshine's Heart,

Well, I had hoped we would be open by mid-March! "Let's stop taking government money, let's become a completely biblical discipleship program, let's remodel the upstairs." Well, as I took inventory or the home, I asked the board if we could **fix everything** needed at WWT while we can." That is what I have been doing at WWT. We bought and secured 5 locking storage cabinets in various areas, we dismantled 6 bunk beds, and moved a lot of THINGS, numerous times, relocated four rooms and everything in them, and the upstairs is now three rooms instead of one. WWT will open June 18th." The last big project: We removed all three sinks in the bathrooms upstairs. The other two sinks are weighing into the drywall, because these sinks are about 25 pounds each. NOW, I must cut into 3 walls and add 2" x 12" lumber, then hang new drywall, mud it and paint it, then reattach the sinks, mirrors, etc. We did receive a quote for over \$3,000 for this project, but.... In 2015, I believed the volunteer who said, "An elephant can't move these sinks, because these brackets are strong." Well, two residents making out on one sink bent the $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick metal bracket and moved it off the wall almost an inch. I am sorry to be so graphic. This is one reason why I said it in my January Newsletter, "NO MORE 18 chances." Through my counseling training I have learned that feeling sorry for unrepentant people is not the love of Christ. Thanks to my board of directors there is no pressure to take just anybody anymore. AND I am grateful that we cut off all government funding; it has all types of expectations attached to it: mandating suboxone or methadone to those coming out of prison or jail; having to allow transgender males at WWT, calling she a he because of feelings. I know that God can heal all people, if the person wants to heal. THAT is now our focus, praying for those ladies who want freedom from addiction. I am grateful for the WWT Board of Directors who are prayer warriors and very mature believers in God, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit. This is why **Romans 12:2, has been so prevalently on my mind for over 2 years.** 'Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.' ONE MORE THOUGHT, to hire adequate staff will require us to raise another \$60,000 by the end of 2024. God blessed us with \$43,000. Of our \$50,000 goal. One couple recently called after reading our request for planned giving gifts. They sent us \$10,000 overnight express. Another lady I met 5 years ago, just happened to send a check for \$5,000. At first I thought these changes would be taunting and nerve racking, but I see AGAIN, that it is the opportunity of a lifetime to TRUST GOD with ALL of my/our hearts! (Proverbs 3:5) We keep asking, and God provides.
