We have **TWO EXPENSIVE, URGENT NEEDS** at the moment:

Our Building and Liability Insurance is due mid March, it cost \$8,323 last year. We were told to expect a 20% increase in 2026.

Our ADA Lift is on a 5' by 8' concrete pad, which is sinking. The ADA Lift needs to be moved, the concrete torn out and re-poured thicker. My guess? Close to \$6,000. We are waiting on a quote. (We have \$3,800 of Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) credits available thru 3-8-2026.)
